

## The **Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP)**

is a community service and work-based job training program for older Americans. Authorized by the Older Americans Act, the program provides training for low-income, unemployed seniors looking to re-enter the workforce.

SCSEP participants gain work experience in a variety of community service activities at non-profit and public facilities, including schools, hospitals, day-care centers, and senior centers. The program provides community service hours to public and non-profit agencies, allowing them to enhance and provide needed services. Participants work 20 hours a week and are paid state or local minimum wage with State and Federal funds- making this opportunity **FREE** and **of no cost to you**. This training serves as a bridge to unsubsidized employment opportunities for participants.

We are looking to expand our partnerships within the community to be able to maximize training opportunities for seniors in your communities as well as referrals of potential participants to this program. Program participants come with valuable experience, determination and dedication.
