



CONTACT TRACER TRAINING PROGRAM

Aligned with CDC training guidelines, this introductory online course will focus on building knowledge about the science of COVID-19, the infectious period, the clinical presentation, the evidence on how it is transmitted from person-to-person and why contact tracing is an effective public health intervention. Students will learn how to build rapport with people who have the virus, identify their contacts, and support both infected people and their contacts to stop transmission in their communities. The course will also cover several important ethical considerations, including HIPAA, cultural sensitivity and diversity surrounding contact tracing. This program is fully online, and students will complete one module a week for four weeks.

Program Requirements

Students must be 18 years or older, have a high school diploma, or equivalent, and have a general proficiency and access in technology.
