## One-time Cash Assistance for Workers

Farmworker & Landscaper Advocacy Project has a one-time, \$500 cash assistance for people financially affected by COVID-19. The assistance is available to residents of Aurora, Cook, Grundy, Jo Daviess, Kankakee, Kendall, and Winnebago counties who are employed in the landscaping, snow plowing, packinghouse, cannery, farms, nursery, greenhouse, meat, and poultry industries, and are not qualified to apply for unemployment and receiving no stimulus check.
