## **Farm Bill increases \$\$ for training, rejects harsh work requirements.**

Thanks to your advocacy, the new Farm Bill **increases money for skills training, and rejects harsh work requirements!**

This week, lawmakers announced they'll renew the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and other safety net programs in the Farm Bill. Some lawmakers [had called for an increase in work requirements](#) for SNAP recipients – even though work requirements often encourage people to take low-wage jobs rather than building skills and earning credentials that lead to family-supporting jobs.

But they heard our coalition's voice! Funding for training has increased, harsh and ineffective work requirements were rejected, and SNAP E&T has been strengthened - it's a huge win for workers and businesses!
