State of the Union: Will Trump's infrastructure plans include skilled workers?

Tomorrow night, President Trump will give his State of the Union address. He's expected to make a case for a new investment in infrastructure - a popular proposal from his campaign. But will he follow through on last year's promise to support one million apprenticeships as part of this package? Nearly half of the estimated 11 million jobs that would be created by a \$1 trillion infrastructure package would require some form of postsecondary education or training. How will we make sure there are enough skilled workers to meet new demand - especially in light of proposed cuts to job training programs?
