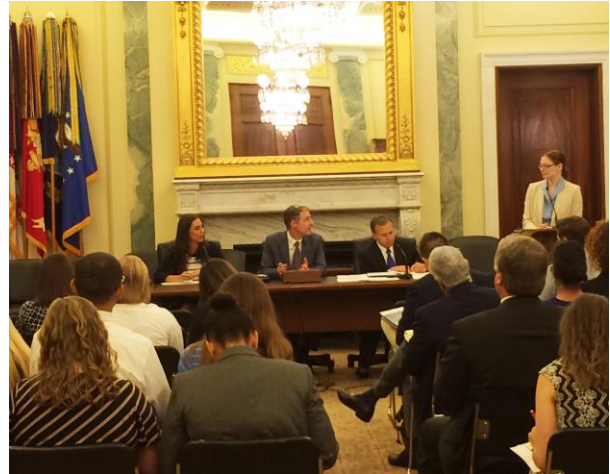
NSC's Congressional briefing draws crowd to learn about upskilling policy
