NBC Nightly News [reported on the skills gap](#) on Friday night, highlighting how U.S. manufacturers are struggling to fill skilled positions. The segment featured [Business Leaders United](#) Chair and CEO of AccuRounds Mike Tamasi. “We’d love to hire people with experience, but there are no people with experience walking the streets. Anyone that has that technical experience already has a job,” Tamasi said.
