Urge your Members of Congress to vote no on House Farm Bill

Later this week, the U.S. House of Representatives is expected to vote on a reauthorization of the federal Farm Bill (H.R. 2) that would significantly expand work requirements for individuals receiving SNAP benefits.

Please take a moment to [ask your Representative](#) to vote “no” on H.R. 2.

According to the nonpartisan [Congressional Budget Office](#), this bill would lead to more than a million low-income workers and other vulnerable adults losing access to SNAP by 2028, and would impose significant administrative burdens on states and training providers in complying with the new requirements.

The bill does [increase](#) funding for the SNAP Employment & Training (SNAP E&T) program, which reflects the growing importance of skills investments for federal policymakers - and the power of your voice here in Washington. But those investments are undermined by work requirements that prematurely push people into training without the necessary supports. We can [do better](#).
