NSC releases new toolkit on work-based learning policies

National Skills Coalition's [new policy toolkit](#) focuses on state policies designed to make work-based learning more available for disadvantaged populations. The toolkit concentrates on policies that combines classroom education with instruction at a worksite (during paid employment) that culminates in an industry-recognized credential.

NSC previously released a [50-State scan](#) that found that several states have enacted work-based learning policies. However, only a few focus on low-skilled populations of out-of-school youth or disadvantaged adults.
